SCHEDULE**PART B: MINIMUM WAGES**

1. Replace **clause 2(1)** as reflected in Government Gazette No.36115 of 05 February 2013 with the following:
‘With effect from 1 March 2016 an employer must pay a farm worker at least the minimum wage prescribed in table 1’
2. Substitute Table 1 as reflected in Government Notice No. 36115 of 05 February 2013 with Table 1 below:
