## **Regulations Regarding the Extent of Official Language Knowledge Required for the Performance of Professional and Official Duties, and Procedures for Testing Fluency of the Language**

*Issued pursuant to Section 6, Paragraph five  
of the Official Language Law  
and Section 50, Clause 3  
of the Education Law*

[19 June 2001]

### **I. General Provisions**

1. These Regulations prescribe the extent of official language knowledge required for the performance of professional and official duties, and the procedures for testing fluency of the official language for the persons referred to in Section 6, Paragraphs one, two and three of the Official Language Law.

2. These Regulations shall not apply to persons who:

- 2.1. have acquired a primary, secondary or higher education in the Latvian language;
- 2.2. [23 January 2001]
- 2.3. are Group I, II and III visually or hearing impaired persons; or
- 2.4. are Group I and II disabled persons with a general illness.

3. The extent of the knowledge of the official language shall be determined in conformity with the nature of occupation and the level of fluency in the official language required for the relevant occupation or position.

4. The level and grade of fluency in the official language required for the performance of professional and official duties of employees of State and local government institutions, courts and institutions belonging to the court system, State and local government undertakings, as well as those companies where the largest capital share is owned by the State or a local government is specified in Annex 1 of these Regulations.

5. The level and grade of fluency in the official language required for the performance of the relevant professional and official duties for employees of private institutions, organisations and undertakings (companies) shall be determined by the employer, for self-employed persons — the self-employed person himself or herself. The level and grade of fluency in the official language required for the performance of the relevant professional and official duties for employees of private institutions, organisations and undertakings (companies) and self-employed persons who, on the basis of law or other regulatory enactments, perform certain public functions, as well as if the activity thereof affects the legal public interest, is specified in Annex 2 of these Regulations. Employees of private institutions, organisations and undertakings (companies) whose occupations or positions are not referred to in Annex 2 of these Regulations, but who in their work have direct contact with consumers, shall provide the consumers with the possibility of receiving the necessary information regarding goods or services.

*[21 November 2000]*

6. An employer shall create a list of positions and occupations in his or her institution specifying the corresponding levels and grades of fluency in the official language (hereinafter — list). The employer may harmonise the list with the State Language Centre.

7. The State Language Centre has a duty to provide an opinion regarding the level and grade of the official language required for the performance of the duties of the relevant occupations or positions upon the request of an employer.

8. Fluency in the official language for the performance of professional and official duties shall be certified by:

8.1. a certificate of fluency in the official language of the appropriate grade issued by a fluency in the official language testing commission (Annex 3), which the person shall present to an employer at his or her request; or

8.2. a primary education or general secondary education certificate specifying the appropriate grade of fluency in the official language, which shall be presented to an employer at his or her request.

*[23 January 2001, 19 June 2001]*

9. Fluency in the official language testing commissions (hereinafter — commission) shall be established by the Minister for Justice and the operation thereof shall be in accordance with a by-law approved by the Minister for Education and Science.

*[23 January 2001]*

10. Persons referred to in Section 6, Paragraphs one, two and three of the Official Language Law and the employer in accordance with the procedures specified in regulatory enactments shall be responsible for the use of the official language in conformity with the requirements specified in regulatory enactments.

## **II. Extent of Knowledge of the Official Language**

11. The extent of knowledge of the official language required for the performance of professional and official duties has been divided into three language fluency levels:

- 11.1. the first (lowest) level;
- 11.2. the second (middle) level; and
- 11.3. the third (highest) level.

12. Each level of fluency in the official language has two grades (A and B):

12.1. first level, grade A — the person is able to elementarily converse on simple everyday subjects, minimally uses the professional vocabulary, reads and understands short, unrelated texts, announcements, advertisements, notices, and is able to write personal data;

12.2. first level, grade B — the person is able to converse in simple sentences on everyday and professional subjects, reads and understands simple texts, and is able to fill in standard documents, forms, invoices, receipts;

12.3. second level, grade A — the person may maintain a simple dialogue on both everyday and professional subjects, reads and understands texts with simple content, and is able to write standard documents, submissions, powers of attorney, deeds, as well as simple texts on everyday or work-related subjects;

12.4. second level, grade B — the person may freely converse on everyday and professional issues, reads and understands texts of various content, and is able to write documents, statements, surveys, minutes, reports, deeds necessary for work, as well as elaborated texts both on everyday and work subjects;

12.5. third level, grade A — the person is able to freely converse, debate, express his or her opinion on both everyday subjects and subjects related to his or her occupation or position, reads and understands texts of various content and difficulty, and is able to write documents, decisions, contracts, articles of association, work descriptions, as well as other writings related to the administration of an institution, undertaking; and

12.6. third level, grade B — the person is able to fully freely converse on both everyday subjects and subjects related to his or her occupation or position, is able to shape the conversation according to the situation, in different styles, is able to vary the linguistic means of expression, and is able to write texts of various difficulty.

12.<sup>1</sup> Level F obtained in the centralised examination of the Latvian language, which is taken by persons to be educated who are acquiring a minority educational programme (hereinafter — centralised examination of the Latvian language) shall correspond to the first level, grade A of the fluency in the official language specified in these Regulations; level E — to the first level, grade B; level D — to the second level, grade A; level C — to the second level, grade B; level B — to the third level, grade A; level A — to the third level, grade B. The description of levels of the centralised examination of the Latvian language shall be determined by the State general education standard and the specific standard of the general education subject.

## **III. Procedures for Testing Fluency in the Official Language**

13. Fluency in the official language required for the performance of professional and official duties of a person to be tested (hereinafter — person) shall be evaluated by the commission in accordance with the methodological instructions approved by the Minister for Education and Science.

*[23 January 2001]*

14. Fluency in the official language shall be tested on the basis of a submission by the person.  
*[6 November 2001; 24 February 2004]*

15. The commission shall evaluate the speaking skills, reading skills and writing skills of the person in general and determine the corresponding level and grade of fluency in the official language.

16. When arriving for a test of fluency in the official language, it is necessary to bring along one's passport and a receipt in respect of the paid State fee.

17. If a person is entitled to pay the State fee in a reduced amount, a document certifying such right shall be taken along to the test.

18. If a person fails to pass the test of fluency in the official language or violates the procedures thereof, the State fee shall not be repaid.

19. Upon arrival in the test room, the person shall present a personal identification document (passport). If the test is taken by a person who is younger than 16 years of age, he or she shall present a birth certificate to the commission.

20. If a person has knowingly performed unlawful activities in order that a decision is taken regarding the issuing of the fluency in the official language certificate, the decision may be revoked in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Law. The person may retake the test not earlier than six months after the day of the previous test.

*[24 February 2004]*

21. Prior to the test of fluency in the official language, the person shall hand over to the secretary of the commission his or her previously acquired fluency in the official language certificate, if any.

22. Textbooks, dictionaries and other study aids are not permitted to be used during the test. If a person fails to pass the fluency in the official language test, or violates the testing regulations, the commission within a period of one month from the day of the previous test shall take a decision regarding the retaking of the test.

*[24 February 2004]*

23. The speaking skills of a person shall be evaluated during an interview (6-7 minutes), determining the level of fluency in the official language of the person in a conversation about work, and subjects related to the occupation or position of the person.

24. In order to test reading and writing skills, the person shall receive test exercises corresponding to his or her occupation or position, subsequent to the completion of which the grade of fluency in the official language of the person shall be determined.

25. The secretary of the commission shall take minutes of the test procedure. Pages of the minutes shall be numbered, all columns completed, and the minutes may not contain deletions, corrections, and erasures.

26. Subsequent to the test of fluency in the official language, the person shall sign in the minutes.
27. Members of the commission shall sign the minutes when the test of fluency in the official language is finished.
28. The secretary of the commission shall seal the minutes with the seal of the commission and send a copy of the minutes to the Centre for Curriculum Development and Examination.  
*[23 January 2001]*
29. An official language fluency certificate may be received from the secretary of the commission after the test. At the request of the person, the commission shall send the certificate in a registered letter by post.
30. If the certificate has been lost, the Centre for Curriculum Development and Examination shall verify whether it was obtained in accordance with the procedures specified in regulatory enactments and issue the certificate again.  
*[6 November 2001]*
31. If a person objects to the evaluation of fluency in the official language or impugns the conformity of the test with regulatory enactments, he or she may submit a relevant submission to the Centre for Curriculum Development and Examination according to the procedures specified in the Administrative Procedure Law.  
*[23 January 2001; 24 February 2004]*
32. The decision of the Centre for Curriculum Development and Examination regarding the conformity of the test procedures with regulatory enactments may be disputed by the person according to the procedures specified in the Administrative Procedure Law.  
*[23 January 2001; 24 February 2003]*
- 32.<sup>1</sup> Persons who have passed the centralised examination of the Latvian language and who are using a primary education or general secondary education certificate to certify the fluency thereof in the official language for the performance of professional and official duties, are not obliged to take the test of fluency in the official language.  
*[23 January 2001, 19 June 2001]*

#### **IV. Closing Provisions**

33. Certificates of fluency in the official language issued from 1992 to 2000 shall be valid after coming into force of these Regulations and the test of fluency in the official language need not be re-taken.
34. The grades specified in the certificates of fluency in the official language issued from 1992 to 2000 shall correspond to the levels of fluency in the official language specified in these Regulations. First level, grades A and B shall correspond to the first (lowest) grade of fluency in the official language. Second level, grades A and B shall correspond to the second (middle) grade of fluency in the official language. Third level, grades A and B shall correspond to the third (highest) grade of fluency in the official language.

35. Up to 1 January 2001, the test of fluency in the official language shall take place in the permanent official language attestation commissions.

36. These Regulations shall come into force on 1 September 2000.

37. By 1 September 2002 the certificate of general secondary education shall be replaced with a document certifying the results of the centralised examination of the Latvian language.

38. Until 1 September 2003, persons to be educated who are acquiring minority education programmes and who, when finishing grade 9, are taking a Latvian language examination shall be granted a grade of fluency in the official language in conformity with the assessment obtained in the Latvian language examination and it shall be entered in the extract of marks of the primary education certificate that shall be presented to the employer at his or her request. 10-9 points obtained in the examination shall correspond to the second level, grade B of fluency in the official language specified in these Regulations, 8-7 points — to the second level, grade A, and 6-5 points — to the first level, grade B, 4 points — to the first level, grade A.

*[19 June 2001]*

39. An educational institution shall make an entry into the extract of marks of the primary education certificate that the person to be educated who is acquiring minority education programmes and, when finishing grade 9, is taking a Latvian language examination, and has been granted an appropriate grade of fluency in the official language.

*[3 July 2001]*

40. The Centre for Curriculum Development and Examination, on the basis of a submission by a person to be educated, shall make an entry into the extract of marks of the primary education certificate that the person to be educated who has acquired minority education programmes and, upon finishing grade 9 in the study year 2000/2001, has passed a Latvian language examination, and has been granted an appropriate grade of fluency in the official language.
