EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION ORDINANCE, CAP. 121

EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2009

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Employees' Compensation Ordinance, Cap. 121, the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Employees' Compensation (Amendment) Regulations, 2009.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on publication and shall apply in respect of any injury sustained or disease contracted on or after that date.

Procedure on application for commutation

2. Regulation 5 of the Employees' Compensation Regulations, Cap. 121, is amended by revoking the proviso to sub-regulation (1).

Deposit

3. Regulation 9 of the Employees' Compensation Regulations, Cap. 121, other than the heading, is revoked and the following is substituted therefor:

"9. An employer depositing compensation in accordance with section 9(3) of the Ordinance shall furnish therewith a statement in Form E, and shall be given a receipt in Form F."

Fees

4. Regulation 52 of the Employees' Compensation Regulations, Cap. 121, is amended by revoking item 3(a) and substituting therefor the following:

“ (a) under section 9(1) of the Ordinance as a result of death of Nil”.

Explanatory Note

The purpose of these Regulations is to introduce consequential amendments to the Employees' Compensation Regulations following the amendment of the Employees' Compensation Ordinance, Cap. 121, to bring it in line with St Helena's obligations under the Workmen's Compensation (Accidents) Convention, 1925 (No. 17).
