

# **Export Enterprises (Remuneration Order) (Amendment) Regulations 2014**

## **THE EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS ACT**

### **Regulations made by the Minister under section 94 of the Employment Relations Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Export Enterprises (Remuneration Order) (Amendment) Regulations 2014**.
2. In these regulations –  
  
    “principal regulations” means the Export Enterprises (Remuneration Order) Regulations 1984.
3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (2), by deleting the words “Additional Remuneration (2013) Act 2012” and replacing them by the words “Additional Remuneration (2014) Act 2013”.
4. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
5. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph 3(2) (b)(ii), by deleting the figure "13.05" and replacing it by the figure "13.86".
6. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2014.
