

**ACT**

of 3 May 2005

**Amending Some Other Acts Consequent on the Adoption of the  
Labour Inspection Act**

Parliament has adopted the following Act of the Czech Republic:

**PART ONE**

**Amendment to the State Occupational Safety Surveillance Act**

**Article I**

The State Occupational Safety Surveillance Act (No. 174/1968) as amended by Act No. 575/1990 Coll., Act No. 159/1992 Coll., Act No. 47/1994 Coll., Act No. 71/2000 Coll., Act No. 124/2000 Coll., Act No. 151/2002 Coll., Act No. 309/2002 Coll., Act No. 320/2002 Coll., Act No. 362/2003 Coll. and Act No. 436/2004 Coll., shall be modified as follows:

1. The Preamble shall be repealed.
2. The heading above Article 1 shall be deleted.
3. In Article 1, Paragraph 1 shall be deleted together with the words “Paragraph 2”.
4. Article 2 shall read as follows:

**“Article 2**

The bodies of state occupational surveillance shall be subordinated to the State Labour Inspection Office. The Minister of Labour and Social Affairs shall appoint and release from office the directors of state occupational surveillance bodies”.

5. The heading above Article 3 shall be deleted.
6. In Article 3, Paragraphs 1 and 2, the words “bodies and” shall be deleted.
7. In Article 3, Paragraph 2, Subparagraph (b) shall read:  
“(b) to technological equipment subject under specific provisions to control by bodies from the sectors of defence, transport and computer science, to sites falling within the scope of the Ministry of the Interior or of an entity in the state structure established to accomplish tasks set by the Ministry of the Interior and to technological installations subject under special legal provisions to control by the State Nuclear Safety Office,”.
8. In Article 3, Paragraph 3 shall be deleted.
9. Articles 4-6, including footnote 3, shall be deleted.
10. In Article 6a, Paragraph 1, the words “Paragraph 2” shall be deleted.

11. In Article 6b, Paragraph 1, sentence two, the hyphen after the word “electric” shall be deleted and replaced by “and” and the words “and in the nuclear energy sector” shall be deleted.
12. In Article 6c, Paragraph 1, Subparagraph (a), the words “and designated installations in the energy sector as well as positions on whether the safety requirements for this type of installations have been met in the course of their designing and construction” shall be deleted.
13. In Article 6c, Paragraph 1, Subparagraph (b), the words “and designated installations in the energy sector” and the words “shall ensure that, in the cases specified, tests, checks, repairs, the assembly or maintenance of the designated technological installations shall only be carried out by persons who are professionally qualified and, in the cases specified, are also certificate holders” shall be deleted.
14. In Article 6c, the full stop at the end of Paragraph 1 shall be replaced by a dash and a subparagraph (c) shall be inserted, which reads:

“(c) shall insure that, in the cases specified, tests, checks, repairs, the assembly or maintenance of the designated technological installations shall only be carried out by persons who are professionally qualified and, in the cases specified, are also certificate holders”.

15. The heading above Article 7 shall be deleted.
16. In Article 7, the words “Bodies and” and the words “to the bodies and” shall be deleted.
17. In Article 7a, Paragraph 1, the words “of the bodies and” shall be deleted.
18. In Article 7b, Paragraph 1, Subparagraphs (b), the words “production” and “and original” shall be deleted.
19. The Annex to Act No. 174/1968 shall be deleted.

## **PART TWO**

### **Amendment to the Employment Act**

#### **Article II**

The Employment Act (No. 435/2004 Coll.), as amended by Act No. 168/2005 Coll. and Act No. 202/2005 Coll., shall be modified as follows:

1. In Article 125, number “4” shall be replaced by number “3”.
  2. In Article 126, Paragraph 1, Subparagraphs (a), the words “with the exception of working conditions deriving from legal provisions designed to ensure safety and health at work<sup>60</sup>”, including footnote 60, shall be deleted.
  3. In Article 126, Paragraph 2 shall be deleted.
