Item 3: Actuarial analysis of the SHIF (SHIF/MC/19/254/3)

The actuary from Aon in charge of the study, Mr. Geert Coene, presents to the MC the proposed assumptions for the base-line scenario of the 2019 actuarial study of the SHIF. He first presents the actuarial methodology that will be used to perform the calculation. He explains in detail the proposed actuarial assumptions. The assumptions are consistent with the assumptions that were used in the previous study as well as with the assumptions that are used in the yearly ASHI valuation.

MC agrees on the assumptions and decides on the sensitivity analysis to include in the study (medical inflation, exchange rate).

It is expected that the actuarial consultant will present the draft results to the MC at its next meeting in July 2019.
