

ILO 90th anniversary celebration in Moldova

Informative note

1/ The ILO 90th anniversary has been marked in Moldova within a national conference under generics “Towards decent work through sound social dialogue” on 29 April in Chisinau. The Deputy Minister of Economy and Trade Mr. Sergiu Sainciuc and representatives of trade unions and employers evaluated the cooperation with the ILO in the framework of the Decent Work Country Programme of Moldova. The relevance of the social dialogue, as pertinent tool in achieving social justice, has been considered by the participants as crucial for the country in facing global crisis consequences. Shortcomings of the social partnership have been mentioned alongside the constituents’ commitments to overcome the pitfalls. The ILO expertise and experience on social dialogue promotion has been reiterated as very valuable for the country’s social partnership mainstreaming. The event has been attended by representatives of government, social partners, civil society, academic media and international organizations.
