



## Partners

Our partners for this project include:

## Beneficiaries

The beneficiaries are 50 PLWAs and 50 victims of the commercial sex trade.

The project will indirectly target other members of WOWOYA SACCO, unemployed youth, Local leaders and other community based organisations by capacity building sessions and integration of HIV/AIDS prevention and control initiatives.

## Expected achievements

- Improvement of status and welfare of 50 PLWAs and 50 commercially sexually exploited young people by sustainable income generating activities;
- Withdraw of women and young people from sexual exploitation;
- Increase in memberships, credit and Loan portfolios for Wowoya SACCO;
- Contribution to the reduction of PLWAs stigmatization as they will be treated equally, readily accepted and welcome in the SACCO.
