

The theme in brief

ILO's mandate for pursuing action against poverty is contained in the Philadelphia Declaration of 1944 which states that "poverty constitutes a danger to prosperity everywhere". ILO has a long history of work on poverty reduction both at the policy level and in practice. This work is now being reinforced in the context of the international commitment to achieve the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs).

The four pillars of ILO's work, namely rights at work, employment, social protection and social dialogue, are mutually reinforcing in addressing poverty reduction. The ILO is currently developing ways of promoting a more coherent approach to addressing poverty reduction as a means for achieving decent work for all.
