## **What is APYouthNet?**

The Asia-Pacific Knowledge Network on Youth Employment (APYouthNet) is a community of practice that connects youth employment experts from across the region. APYouthNet aims to bring together individuals engaged in designing and implementing policies and programmes which promote decent and productive work for young women and men. A lively network can benefit everyone. By sharing information and experiences we can better understand youth employment challenges in the region and work towards achieving decent work for young people. This is being launched within the framework of the Asian Decent Work Decade as part of the [Asia-Pacific Knowledge Network on Decent Work](#).

## **APYouthNet Members**

Members will be drawn from governments, employers' and workers' organizations, academia, NGOs, civil society organizations and international organizations who wish to achieve decent work for youth.

## **APYouthNet Features**

APYouthNet will offer a number of features to help members share knowledge and advance the goal of decent work for young people:

**E-Group:** The E-Group will allow members to send and answer queries, engage in discussions, share new publications and promote events. Members would receive emails from other network members sent via an ILO mailbox to ensure privacy.

**New Youth Employment Website:** A new youth employment webpage linked to the revamped ILO regional website will be a rich source of information on youth employment and related issues – making it easier than ever to access relevant ILO tools and publications.

**Online Discussion Forum:** Depending on the response during this initial phase, we plan to activate a web-based platform which will enable dialogue and provide space for storing information and contributions from members.

**Events:** In the future, we will also find opportunities to bring APYouthNet members together face to face.
