- Use map of GMS, with your country highlighted, and draw major sites of trafficking (sources and destinations).
- Discuss and agree as group on the main trafficking movements of people from, to, through and within your country and draw corresponding arrows on the map!
 - Map out patterns for major sectors (e.g. migration routes for fishing industry)
 - Consider **gender**: Discuss at least 3 destination sectors where males end up working and 3 sectors where females end up (either as migrants or as a result of trafficking) and list them in the same map.
 - In addition to gender, consider **age** as an important factor: How do migration/trafficking routes differ for children?
 - Discuss at least 3 types of people that facilitate the migration, act as traffickers and/or exploiters (e.g. those exploiting children, as recruiters, transporters, intermediaries, clients, unscrupulous employers) and list them in the map. Who are the main exploiters?
