# Compliance- submission of GAD Plans and Accomplishment Reports

## ➤ 379 government agencies

(includes: attached agencies, GOCCs, state colleges and universities, constitutional bodies)

➤ low compliance GAD Plan submission – average 132 (35%) (2004-2008)

➤ low compliance GAD Accomplishment Report Submission – decreasing trend (2004-2006)





# GAD Allocations and Expenditure

## *Allocations*

less than 1% of total gov't appropriations for the year



## *Expenditure*

Average (2002-2006) – 41%





# Notable Agency Programs, Projects, Activities (PPAs) supported by the GAD Budget for Women's Econ Empowerment

## Trainings

- environment-appropriate technologies; livelihood trng for women in indigenous communities; good manufacturing practices; provision of equipment to women's organizations to improve production (DOST)
- Agricultural technologies (DA)
- Entrepreneurship (TESDA, DTI)
- livelihood skills training for female inmates (DILG- Bureau f Jail Mgmt)





# Notable Agency Programs, Projects, Activities (PPAs) supported by the GAD Budget for Women's Econ Empowerment

Sex-disaggregated data- business name registration (DTI)

Trade fairs for women entrepreneurs (DTI)





# Notable Agency Programs, Projects, Activities (PPAs) supported by the GAD Budget for Women's Econ Empowerment

## Implementation of Labor Standards Enforcement Framework

- Monitoring compliance with laws and standards related to women workers (call centers) (DOLE)



## Org'n of women for involvement in promotion of sustainable eco-tourism (DENR)





# Challenges

- lack of understanding and appreciation of value-added of integrating GAD in agency policies and programs
- weak mechanisms to support integration of GAD in agency
- sex-disaggregated and/or gender data as basis for planning
- attribution

- making the 95% of agency budget gender-responsive
- Monitoring actual expenditures
- ensuring continuity of notable client-focused programs and activities
- tracking outcomes
