**on the events organized in Ukraine**  
**on the occasion of the ILO 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary**  
**and 55<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Ukraine's membership in the ILO**

**In 2009 the ILO and its members celebrate the 90th anniversary of the Organization's formation in 1919.** To mark this event, special events have been held in more than 120 countries under the banner of "90 years working for social justice".

The events organized in Ukraine by the office of the ILO National Coordinator in Ukraine with involvement of the ILO Projects' staff as well as those organized by the national partner organizations (Ministry of Labour and Social Policy and social partners, regional executive authorities) have become part of the worldwide information campaign devoted to the ILO Anniversary.

#### **Events organized in Ukraine at the national and regional levels**

1. In Ukraine, the national campaign on the ILO's 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary started with a **presentation of up to 100 ILO publications in the National Library of Ukraine named after V. Vernadsky and National Parliamentarian Library on 14 and 16 April, 2009.**

The objective of the events was to increase awareness among the general public about ILO, its policy and achievements in Ukraine on the occasion of ILO 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, to provide access to the ILO materials for the students, scientists and general public.

The ILO National Coordinator made the overview of the ILO mission and policies, cooperation of the ILO with Ukraine and achievements of the last decade of cooperation. The ILO Projects' managers presented the achievements of the projects and strategic objectives set for the future. In particular the ILO contribution to reforming of the labour code, strengthening the social dialogue, to elimination of child labour, human trafficking, to ensuring equal opportunities for men and women in the labour market and increasing access of people with disabilities to employment opportunities, were discussed. The national partners spoke about benefits the cooperation with ILO delivered to them. The exhibition in the National Parliamentarian Library was attended by the Ambassador of Belgium in Ukraine Marc Vinc, Head of the Committee of the Parliament on Veterans, Pensioners and Disabled, Valeriy Sushkevych, Deputy Head of the Committee of the Parliament on Social Policy and Labour, Oleg Shevchuk, representatives of the all-Ukrainian employers' organizations and trade unions as well as of the educational institutions. The Exhibitions were attended by the visitors of the libraries, students and staff of the libraries (at least 90 persons). All the publications represented and the CD's with the ILO conventions and recommendations were handed over to the libraries (for the UN Room in National Vernadsky Library and thematic rooms of the National Parliamentarian Library).

2. **The ILO press club in Ukraine on 21 April** was also dedicated to the 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The objective of the meeting was to provide information resources to the mass media representatives to enable them to disseminate information about ILO in general and ILO activities in Ukraine. At the press club the social partners and government officials spoke about the ILO's policies and achievements in Ukraine to journalists coming from various media.
3. On the 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> April round-tables and conferences on the occasion of the ILO's 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and 55<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Ukraine's membership in the ILO were conducted in many regions of Ukraine, particularly in Luhansk, Donetsk, Cherkassy and Dnipropetrovs'k oblasts (regions). They were initiated by the national partner institutions.

On the 29<sup>th</sup> April a Tripartite round-table was organized in Chernigiv region by social partners: the Main Department of Labour and Social Protection for the Population of Chernigiv regional state administration, Federation of Trade Union organizations of Chernigiv Oblast as well as Regional Federation of Employers (affiliated to the Federation of Employers of Ukraine). Around 40 participants took part in this tripartite round-table. The ILO National Coordinator in Ukraine, Vasyl Kostyrytsya delivered a main speech, in particular, read a message by Juan Somavia Director-General of the International Labour Office on the occasion of the ILO's 90th anniversary "90 years working for social justice"; and shared an information on the history of the organization, its principles of work and implementation of Decent Work Country Programme in Ukraine. The Head of the Department of International Relations of the Federation of Trade Unions of Ukraine, Vasyl Shilov also participated in this tripartite round-table. Information on this round-table was covered by two regional (oblast) newspapers as well as on Oblast TV Channel and radio.

4. The national campaign culminated by **All-Ukrainian Tripartite Conference on the occasion of the ILO's 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and 55<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Ukraine's membership in the ILO**, conducted in Kyiv on 28 April. It was organized under the special Order of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine. With this purpose the Tripartite organizing committee was established chaired by the Minister of Labour and Social Policy Liudmyla Denisova and composed of the representatives of the Ministry of Labour and Social Policy, other ministries and committees and of the trade unions and employers' organizations. The ILO National Coordinator was a member of this Committee.

At the Conference, conducted in the Club of the Cabinet of Minister of Ukraine, Viktor Ivankevych, Deputy Minister of Labour and Social Policy of Ukraine, spoke about the cooperation of Ukraine and ILO as the strategy for decent work in Ukraine. The social partners evaluated the ILO's role in the introduction and development of social dialogue in Ukraine and how social dialogue can become a key to wellbeing and prosperity. The

addresses of the President of Ukraine Viktor Yushchenko, the Prime-Minister of Ukraine Yuliya Tymoshenko and the Ombudsperson Nina Karpachova were pronounced by their representatives at the Conference. Up to 100 participants including ILO constituents, members of Parliament of Ukraine, representatives of embassies based in Kiev, UN Country Team, EC Delegation to Ukraine, etc. took part in the event.

The Conference was followed by the briefing for the mass media.

5. The 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the ILO was also highlighted at the official launch of the EC-ILO Project "Gender equality of men and women in the world of work" by Mr. Mark Levin, Director of the ILO SRO-Budapest and Sergiy Savchuk, Project National Coordinator. Vasyl Kostyrytsya, ILO National Coordinator in Ukraine gave the interviews to the First National Radio Channel, 3 TV channels during the All-Ukrainian Tripartite Conference on 29 April and participated in the talk-show on 5<sup>th</sup> Channel on 1 May. National Manager of the IPEC Programme in Ukraine gave interview to the weekly newspaper of the Ministry of Interiors "In the name of law" which will be published on 8 May 2009.
