- ◆ population of 620,145 (MONSTAT, census 2003)
- ◆ population growth in 1990 - 8.9%,
2004- 3.5%[\[1\]](#)
- ◆ older people (65 or more)- 11.9% of the total population.
- ◆ young people (up to 19) - 44% in 1953
27% in 2003
- ◆ ISSP LFS ,2007, economically active young people,
15-19 cohort- 1,78%,
20-24 cohort- 49,34%.
- ◆ MONSTAT LFS,2005, economically inactive young people,
cohort 15-19- 86,6%
cohort 20-24- 40,6%.
