



## DISTRIBUTION OF RELIEF GOODS TO FLOOD VICTIMS

The ILO Staff Union colleagues from our Country Office for Pakistan in Islamabad organised a collection and donated emergency goods to help the flood victims in the Province of Sind (relief camp in the district Sukkurr). According to official estimates the Sukkurr district is one of the most heavily affected areas and has 39% of its surface submerged in water. It suffered great losses in human lives, live stock, infrastructure and agriculture. On Sunday 22 August Mr. Donglin Li, (Country Director) together with Mr. Razi Mujtaba Haider (Staff Union representative) of the ILO Office for Pakistan went themselves to distribute 225 bags containing mineral water, powdered milk, liquid milk and soap. On Monday 30 August, a second visit to two other flood affected areas was organised (Nowshera and Peshawar) for further distribution of goods.
