### [The global economic crisis and migrant workers](#)

Genève : BIT, 2009, 64p.

Analyses the actual and potential impact of the global crisis on international migrant workers through a focus on four issue areas. These are the employment and migration opportunities available to migrant workers, including changes in the demand for migrant labour and possible return to countries of origin; the volume of financial remittances sent by migrant workers to their families; situations of discrimination and xenophobia that may confront migrant workers along with their conditions of work and; the policies that both countries of destination and origin have put in place to deal with the impact of the crisis.

Focuses on strengthening trade unions' capacity to participate in the shaping of migration policies, promote sound labour migration practices and reach out to migrant workers.

Analyses effective labour migration policies and practices. Emphasizes that successful management of labour migration requires a deliberate approach to address the range of policy issues and choices involved.

Presents the ILO's perspective on the relationship between international labour migration and development. Reviews the importance of migrant workers to development in destination and origin countries and outlines the need for protecting migrant workers from abuse and providing them with rights.

Briefly outlines the basic normative framework for the protection of the rights of migrant workers, which includes the 1998 ILO Declaration of Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work and its follow-up, ILO Conventions specifically pertaining to migrant workers, and other Conventions which are particularly important to the situation of workers employed in countries other than their own.
