

**ILO and UN Resident Coordinators Dialogue

Lima, Peru, 17-18 September 2019

INFORMATION NOTE

Participants should take into consideration the following logistic note in order to facilitate their participation in this meeting.

1. Meeting venue and dates

The meeting will be held at the ILO's Regional Office for Latin America and the Caribbean (Auditorium III), located on Calle Las Flores 275, San Isidro, Lima; phone: +511 615-0300, +511 615-0368.

2. Working languages

The meeting will be carried out in Spanish. There will be simultaneous interpretation to and from English.

3. Travel documents

Before leaving their country, participants should verify if visas, vaccination certificates and other travel documents are required to enter Peru. According to local regulations, passports must be valid at least six months from the date of arrival.

4. Transportation Airport-Hotel-Airport

The ILO will provide transfer upon your arrival to Lima. A person from the taxi company will be waiting for you at the Jorge Chavez airport with a sign indicating the participant's name. In order to coordinate these transfers, we would appreciate receiving your confirmation and a copy of your itinerary as soon as possible.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Weather

It is winter in September in Lima. The temperature is around 17°C. Humidity is around 90%.

Currency

The local currency is the Peruvian Sol. The exchange rate for the US dollar is around 3.33 Soles per dollar. It is recommended to exchange money in Money Exchange Offices (Okane Exchange Office located one block from the ILO office, in block 15 of the Dos de Mayo Avenue) and/or banks. All major international credit cards: Visa, Mastercard and American Express are accepted in most establishments.

Trade and banks

Shops, malls and craft markets open every day (including holidays). Salaverry Mall, Av. Salaverry 2370, Jesús María, is located just 4 blocks from the hotel Dazzler and is opened Monday to Sunday from 10 to 22 hours. The bank office hours are: 9 to 18 from Monday to Friday, and Saturday morning.

Security

In Lima, as in any other major city, visitors should take precautions to minimize risks: avoid informal taxis, pay close attention to personal belongings in public places, be careful when drawing money from cash machines, avoid being out late at night or in unsafe areas, and never lose sight of credit or debit cards in establishments or restaurants, among others.

Transport services

Public transportation as buses and combis and informal or street taxis are not recommended.
