National Consultation on
Youth Employment in Jordan

(Amman, Jordan, 18 April 2012)

Beirut (ILO News) – The International Labour Organization (ILO) and the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) will be organizing a national consultation on youth employment in Amman on Thursday 19 April 2012 at the ECOSOC premises (Shmeisani), in a bid to map out current activities, and identify potential synergies.

The consultation will bring together relevant stakeholders tackling the youth employment challenge in Jordan, including government, workers' and employers' representatives, international organizations and youth organizations, with the aim of reaching a common understanding on the issues at hand, improving coordination, and sharing good practices from the relevant policies and interventions. The consultation ultimately seeks to create a national platform for interaction and coordination on youth employment issues so as to strengthen the combined impact of youth employment initiatives on a national level.
