This workshop brings together around 45 government, employer, worker and civil society representatives to develop a National Policy on HIV and AIDS and World of Work in line with the Jordan National Strategic Plan and to give effect to ILO Recommendation No.200. The workshop and its outcomes will contribute to the achievement of Goal 6a of the Millennium Development Goals: Halt and begin to reverse the spread of HIV/AIDS.

Objectives:

- To examine the Jordanian legal and policy environment to strengthen policies and programmes on HIV and AIDS in the world of work in Jordan
- To establish a technical committee on HIV and AIDS and world of work
- To draft a national policy on HIV and AIDS and the world of work in Jordan
