REGULATION FOR PHOTO COMPETITION AND EXHIBITION *“Child protection – Let’s end child labour!”*

The Bureau of child protection and care under MOLISA, the Vietnam Professional Photographers Association, The Social and Labour Newspapers, and the Family and Children Magazine would like to invite professional and amateur photographers, journalists, persons who pay attention to children issues, and children to take part in the National Photo Competition “*Child Protection – Let’s end child labour!*”. The competition is funded by the International Labour Organization (ILO), World Vision (WV), and Save the Children...

I. MEANING AND OBJECTIVES OF THE COMPETITION

Nowadays, there are 215 million children engaging in working, in which 115 million involved in hazardous work worldwide. In Vietnam, the number of children in hazardous work is 100,000 children engaged in economic activities, in which about 10-15% working in hazardous working conditions. These figures urged us to find more effective measures to eliminate worst forms of child labour by 2016.

Annually, 12th June is the World Day against Child Labour.

This year the World Day Against Child Labour will provide a spotlight on *the right of all children to be protected from child labour and from other violations of fundamental human rights.*

Activities to observe the World Day Against Child Labour aim to promote awareness and action to tackle child labour. Support for the World Day has been growing each year and in 2012 we look forward to a World Day that will again be widely supported.

Photo competition on the topic of “*Child protection – Let’s end child labour!*” aims to:

- Observe the World Day Against Child labour;
- Provide the public with imaged information on street children or children who have to work in hazardous conditions; actions by authorities at different levels, social organizations, and interventions of community to eradicate street children and child labour.

- Do advocacy towards society on child protection, prevent and support street children, child labour; prevent organizations/individuals in exploiting child labour;

- Give chances for children to engage in education, entertainment, and full development.

II. CANDIDATES

- Both Vietnamese citizens and foreigners living in Vietnam can send photos to the competition. Children are encouraged to participate in the competition.

- Members of Organization Committee/Judging Panel (primary round and final round) are not allowed to participate in the competition but can send photos to be selected for the exhibition; and their photos are selected fairly as others according to the regulation of the competition.

III. CONTENT – THEME OF THE COMPETITION

“*Child protection – Let’s end child labour!*” is the theme of the competition, thus, photos to be sent to the competition must honestly reflect lives and fates of children who have to strive to make a living in such a way to ensure the respect of child rights; praise and honour actions to support children, eliminate street children, and child labour; criticize and condemn persons who abuse and exploit children. In addition, thanks to photo-taking skills, candidates can express the aspiration and dream of children in general, street children, and child labour in hazardous work in particular.

IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PHOTOS FOR THE COMPETITION

The photos to be sent to this competition have never been sent to other previous competition; have never been posted on mass media; the photos should be taken from 2010 up to now in the territory of Vietnam; the main character in the photo is people under 18 years old.

1. Photo can be single photo which is no need to be in series, either in colour or black and white, printed in photographic paper, not paste on hard cover; Photos should be sent by post or directly deliver to receiver.

Size: shortest dimension is not under 10 cm, and the longest dimension is not exceed 45 cm.

Specify full name, date of birth (age), address, telephone/mobile (if any) of the candidate; name of the photo and its meaning.

2. Photo File from 1Mb to 8Mb should be sent through email or bring to the office of Social and Labour Newspapers and the Family and Children Magazine.

Number of photos to be sent: Each candidate can select and send maximum 5 photos.

V. TIME AND ADDRESS TO RECEIVE PHOTO

- Time: from **06/4/2012 to 30/5/2012**.

For photos to be sent by post: deadline is **30/5/2012** according to the stamp of the post office. The envelop cover should specify

VI .RESPONSIBILITIES OF CANDIDATES

- Candidates are responsible to follow the regulations of the competition; show the truthfulness of the photo; agree and commit to transfer the right to use their photos to the Organization Board voluntarily.

- Winners are responsible to pay tax according to existing law.

- If the photo is detected to violate the copyright regulation, the Organization Board will cancel the result and the prize (if any) for that photo.

VII. USE OF PHOTOS

- Photos that are selected in the primary round will be posted on **the Family and Children Magazines** and **The Social and Labour Newspapers**.

- Photos that are awarded 1st prize, second prize, and third prize will be given certificate by the **Vietnam Professional Photographers Association**.

- Beside 16 photos that are awarded, the Organization Committee will select additional 55 photos entered the final round to print for exhibition; photo royalties will be paid for these 55 photos at the rate of 300,000 VND/photo.

- Awarded and exhibited photos are not returned to the author. The Organization committee is allowed to use them for communication purpose and publication, not for commercial purpose, and the organization committee doesn't have to pay any fee for the author. Ethic right belongs to author.

VIII. GRADING AND PRIZE STRUCTURE

- The Organization Committee establishes Juding Panel for the primary round and final round consisting of managers, experienced journalist, professional photographer, and children.

- Prize structure:

01 first prize: Certificate and 15 million VND

02 second prize: Certificate and 10 million VND

03 third prize: Certificate and 5 million VND

10 motivation prize: Certificate and 2 million VND

55 photos to be selected for exhibition: 300.000VND/photo (photo royalties)

Beside official prizes, the Organization Committee will mobilize fund from other donors for motivation prizes.

IX. EXHIBITION OPENING AND PRIZE AWARD CEREMONY

- The Organization Committee provide allowance (meal, accommodation, transportation) for the first and second prizes to attend the prize award ceremony to be organized in Hanoi.

- The organization committee will send certificate, prize, photo royalties (for photos to be selected for exhibition) by post to the address posted on the photo for those who get the third prize and motivation prize./.
