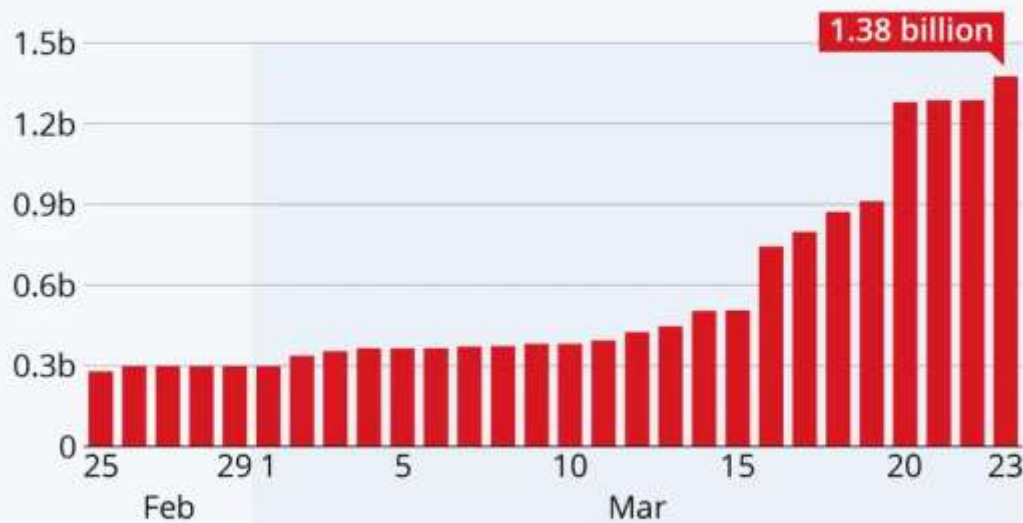
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# COVID-19's Staggering Impact On Global Education

## National standards

- National Training Packages
- Course accreditation
- Data provision for government
- Standards for training organisations to be registered



## National qualifications framework

### *Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF)*

- 10 levels
- Links schools, VET and higher education



## National VET regulator

### *Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA)*

Registers & monitors over 4,000 registered training organisations (RTOs) against national standards

\* Victoria and Western Australia have their own state regulators
