

Annual real GDP growth rate (%)





Growth rate of labour productivity







Growth rate of labour productivity





Employment-to-population ratio (%)







Global unemployment and unemployment rate (%)






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Philippines - unemployment and unemployment rate (%)


VULNERABLE EMPLOYMENT

Philippines - vulnerable employment and rate (%)





• The ILO was founded in 1919 to promote social justice and internationally recognized human and labour rights through:



- unique "tripartite" structure brings together governments, employers and workers organizations from 185 member States
- promoting decent and productive work for all




















- Strong cultural link with ancestral territories
- Major development challenges:
 - Degradation of their resource base;
 - Marginalization;
 - Conflict;
 - Lack of opportunity to develop their capacities; and
 - Increasing inadequacy in their livelihoods





Indigenous Peoples Rights Act (IPRA) and ILO Convention 169







ILO Convention169 on Indigenous and Tribal Peoples and IPRA – promote common approaches

- Provide comprehensive framework for effective development approaches affecting indigenous peoples
- Added value:
 - Indigenous peoples as contributors to national economic development
 - Tool for good and inclusive governance = Consultation and Participation, Indicator of enhanced democracy
 - Enhanced security for public and private investments

Freedom of Association (FOA)



- "The right of workers and employers to freely form or join organizations that promote and defend their interests at work without interference from one another or the State." (ILO)
- Researches show that respect and observance of Freedom of Association rights ensure:
 - Workplace inclusiveness and collaboration
 - Increased productivity/economic growth
 - Better dispute resolution and partnership
 - Safer working environments
 - Strengthened democracy, stability and cooperation





Freedom of Association (FOA)



2009 ILO High Level Mission to Philippines – response to concerns of ILO supervisory body

- Findings identified several issues:
 - National law not in compliance with international law
 - Capacity building of key employment actors
 - Investigating allegations of trade union busting and harassment of trade union officials
- ILO and social partners working together
 - Support and capacity building
