## APPLICATION FOR INTERPRETATION

An application for interpretation may only be filed for the purpose of clarifying the <u>decision point</u> which appears at the end of the judgment. However, if the decision refers explicitly to one or more of the considerations of the judgment, the application for interpretation may also extend to those specific considerations. The application for interpretation may be admissible only if the judgment concerned is insufficiently clear or ambiguous, which would have impact on its execution.

The application for interpretation may only be filed by one of the parties mentioned in the judgment concerned.

The application for interpretation can be filed as soon as the judgment is published.
