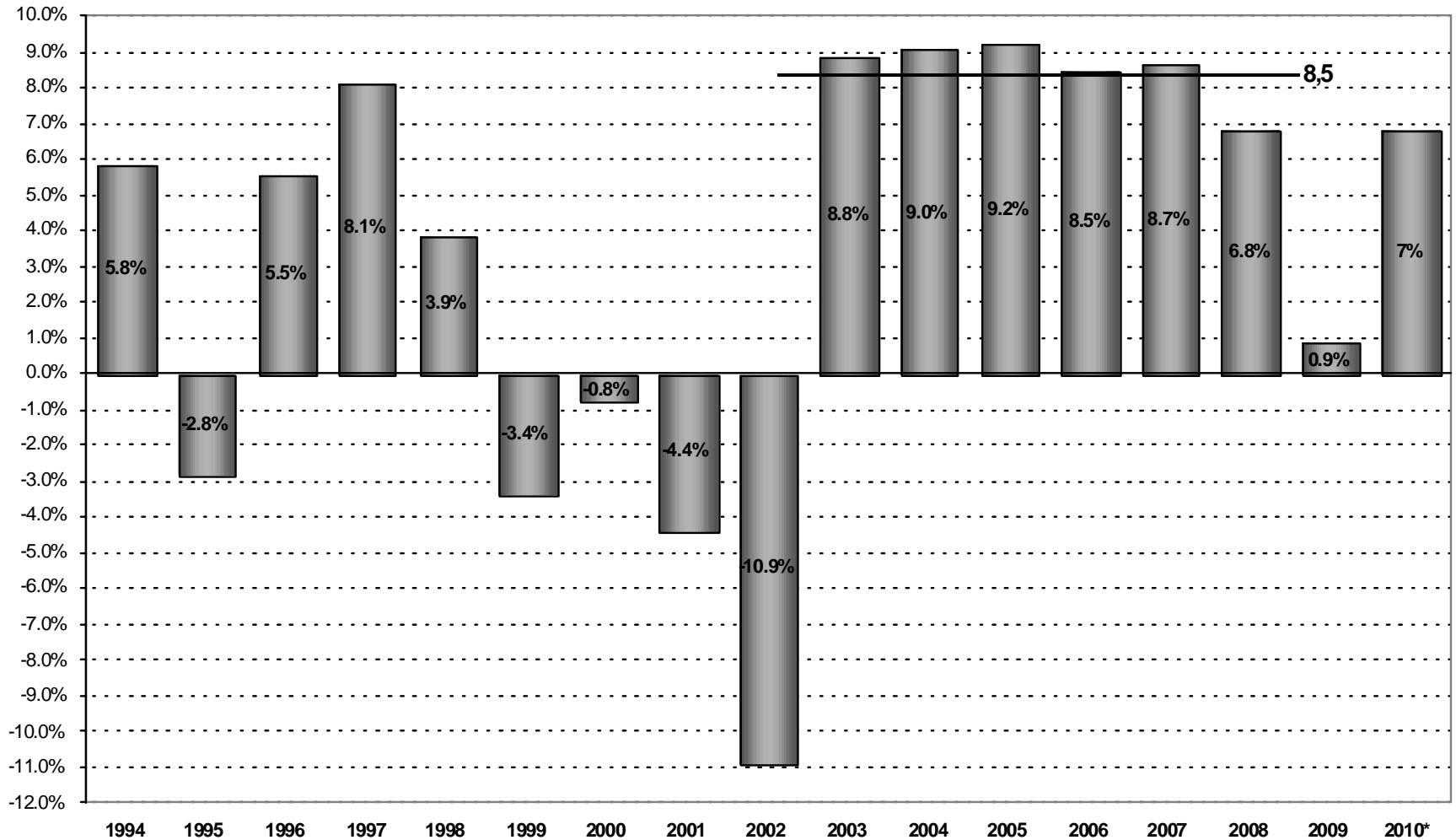

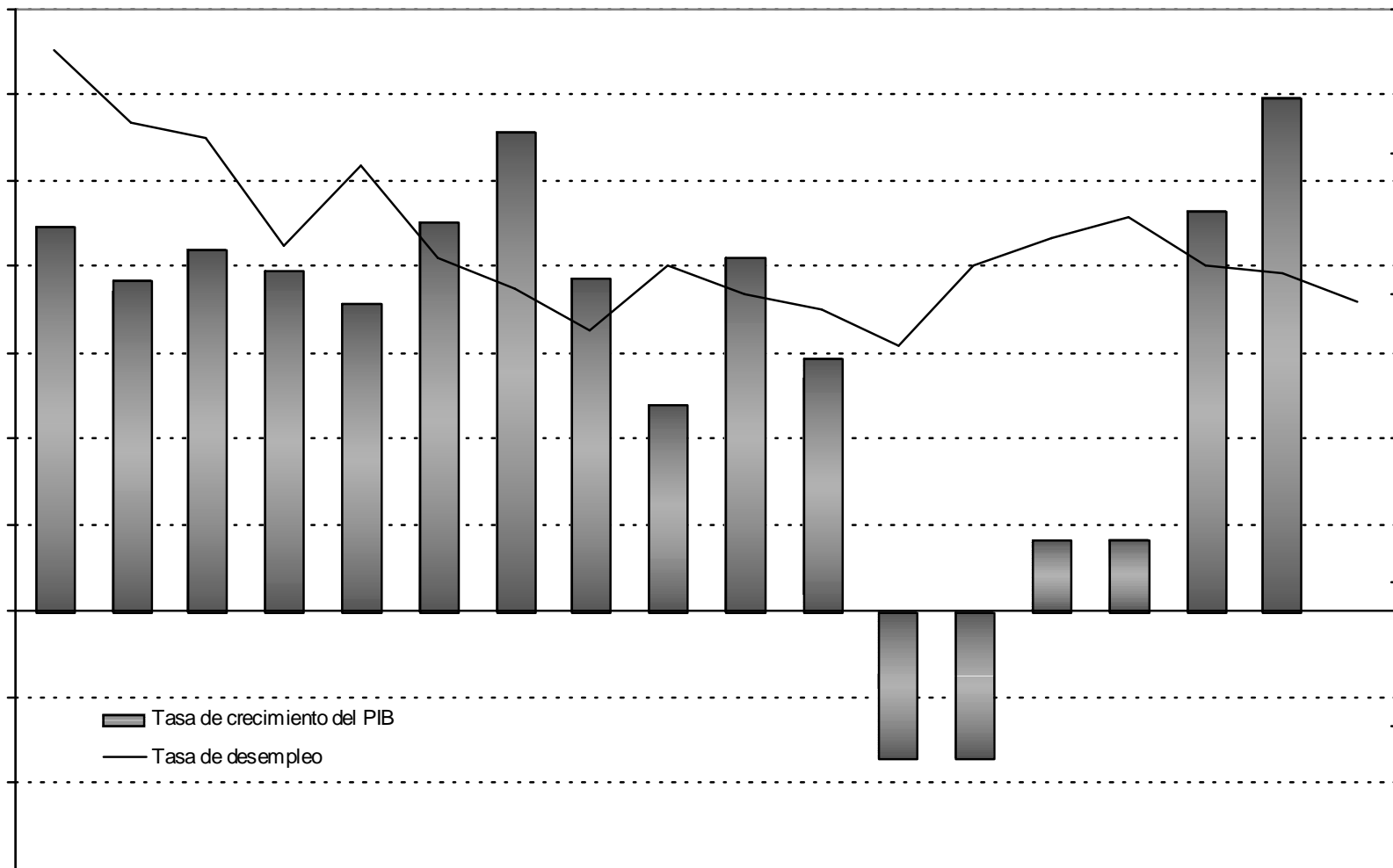
# Argentina: GDP growth 1994-2010
