

ILO organized a Tripartite Achievement Workshop in Thailand

Bangkok – 19-22 January, 2009

ILO/CRISIS and ILO SRO of East Asia organized a Tripartite Achievement Workshop in Bangkok that brought to accomplishment the project "Avian and Human Influenza and the Workplace" (Thailand). This event aimed at raising awareness on Avian Influenza and Pandemic Human Influenza with a special emphasis on issues related to livelihoods support.

During this Workshop, participants learned about the project's key activities and examined the training materials developed under the programme.

The achievements and good practices emerged from the Thailand experience were illustrated through presentations and groupworks. Subsequently, key actions for the future were identified, and ways to export successful initiatives to the neighbouring countries were explored.

Two separate panel discussions were held on the national strategies concerning Avian Influenza and Pandemic Human Influenza. On these occasions, tripartite representatives had the chance to exchange views and ideas.
