ILO Decent Work Research Prize

The second ILO Decent Work Research Prize will be announced in plenary **today, Friday 13 June**, before the closing ceremony of the Conference. Prize winners are **Nobel Prize winning economist, Joseph Stiglitz, and leading Canadian labour researcher Harry Arthurs.**



Professor Joseph Stiglitz, who received the Nobel Prize in economics in 2001, is also Chair of Columbia University's Committee on Global Thought, former Chief Economist of the World Bank and a member of the World Commission on the Social Dimension of Globalization. Professor Stiglitz was named for his extraordinary lifetime contribution to knowledge on the central concerns of the ILO and its constituents, reflecting advances in understanding of different dimensions of decent work.



Professor Harry Arthurs, former Dean of Osgoode Hall Law School at York University in Toronto, Canada and former President of the University is the author of a report to the Canadian government of "Fairness at Work. Federal Labour Standards for the 21st Century", submitted in 2006. Professor Arthurs was cited for a major specific contribution to the understanding of socio-economic relationships and policy instruments for the advancement of decent work.

The attribution of the prize was decided by a jury of eminent international experts in labour and social policy issues.
