**Membership of the Board of the  
International Training Centre**

1. Following each new election of the members of the Governing Body, it is also necessary to appoint the members of the Board of the International Training Centre in Turin. These appointments are normally made from among the candidates for membership of the Governing Body and conform to the composition provided for by the Centre's own Statute.
2. According to article III, paragraph 2(c) of the Statute, the Board includes 24 members appointed by the Governing Body of the International Labour Office from among its own members, including six members of the Government group who represent Members of the International Labour Organization of chief industrial importance. Italy has its own seat on the Board of the Centre.
3. This year, following the elections in June 2008, only five of the Members of the International Labour Organization of chief industrial importance expressed an interest in having a seat on the Board of the Centre. Consequently, in order not to deprive the Board of the number of votes required to adopt its decisions, it is proposed that the Government of Spain should be authorized to appoint a representative as a member of the Board for the period 2008–11.
4. *In the light of the foregoing considerations, the Committee may wish to recommend to the Governing Body that it appoint a representative of the Government of Spain as a member of the Board of the Turin Centre for the period 2008–11.*
