**Matters relating to the Administrative
Tribunal of the ILO: Statute of the Tribunal**

1. In November 2009 the Governing Body deferred to the current session a review of the question of the possibility for staff unions and associations to file complaints in their own name before the Administrative Tribunal of the International Labour Organization.
2. The document presented by the Office in November ¹ contained an update of developments ² and in that context proposed that the Committee recommend that the Governing Body place this item on the agenda of its 310th Session (March 2011) for its review, based on the outcome of the 65th Session of the United Nations General Assembly and any other relevant developments.
3. Since it could not reach agreement on the Office proposal, the Committee recommended that the Governing Body postpone consideration of the item to its current session ³ and it was so decided.
4. No developments are to be reported since last November. The point for decision of the earlier document is therefore proposed again without changes.
