1. The Finance Committee of Government Representatives met on 1 June 2018. Ambassador Negash Kebret Batora (Ethiopia) was elected Chairperson and Reporter and Mr Byeong Hee Kwon (Republic of Korea) was elected Vice-Chairperson.

## **Status of collection of member States' contributions**

2. The Committee had before it document [C.F./D.2](#) on the status of collection of member States' contributions as at 18 May 2018.
3. A representative of the Director-General (Treasurer and Financial Comptroller) reported that in addition to the information contained in the Office paper, contributions for 2018 and prior years amounting to 5,962,626 Swiss francs (CHF) had been received from six member States as follows:

Including contributions received between 19 May 2018 and 1 June 2018, the total contributions received in 2018 amounted to CHF273,045,433. Of this amount, CHF211,338,569 represented contributions for 2018 and CHF61,706,864 represented contributions for arrears. The balance due as of 1 June 2018 was CHF272,631,734.
