Dear Chairperson of the Governing Body,

On behalf of the Government of Ghana, I have the honour and pleasure to nominate Mr. Guy Ryder to the position of Director General of the International Labour Organisation (ILO), for another five-year term, in response to your letter dated 18th April, 2016 regarding the appointment of the Director General.

My Ministry has followed with keen interest, the positive developments that have taken place since the appointment of Mr. Ryder as Director General of the ILO, an organization which he already was very much part of and had worked extensively for, even before his election as Director General in 2012.

The process of reform to strengthen the ILO's technical capacity, the progressive collaboration of the ILO with the multilateral system, the various initiatives targeted at making the ILO more responsive to the world of work and the increased visibility of the organization, are only a few of the many instances of his impact, over the last few years.
