## OF THE CABINET OF MINISTERS OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN DECISION

### ON THE MEASURES TO ENSURE THE EMPLOYMENT OF WOMEN IN THE NEIGHBORHOODS AND ORGANIZE THE ACTIVITIES OF HEALTH PROMOTION CENTERS

**Decree** No. PF-87 dated March 7, 2022 of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On measures to further accelerate work on the systematic support of families and women" and "Increasing the employment of women and girls and on additional measures to strengthen health" to ensure the implementation of the **decision** PQ-376 of September 21, 2022, as well as to increase the social and economic activity of women in society, to train them in the profession and entrepreneurial skills In order to ensure employment through training and organize health promotion activities in neighborhoods, the Cabinet of Ministers decides:

1. The following:

a) **In accordance with paragraph 15 of the** Decree No. PF-87 dated March 7, 2022 of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On measures to further accelerate work on the systematic support of families and women" :

organization of women's employment and health promotion centers (hereinafter referred to as centers);

The Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, regional and Tashkent city governments will divide the land area of up to 300 square meters from each neighborhood into neighborhoods based on the right of permanent use or the right to operational management of vacant state-owned objects;

that the centers' buildings are leased by the neighborhoods to business entities for the organization of tailoring, confectionery, fitness, shaping, vocational training for women;

b) **In accordance with paragraph 4 of the** decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On additional measures to increase the employment of women and strengthen their health" dated September 21, 2022 PQ-376 :

establishment of centers by district (city) governments at the expense of additional sources of local budgets and other funds not prohibited by law;

Center buildings will be leased for a period of 5 years to business entities for the organization of tailoring, confectionery, fitness, shaping, women's vocational training activities in accordance with the procedure for leasing state property based on the recommendation of women's activists in the neighborhoods by the neighborhood citizen meetings;

in order to ensure the permanent employment of up to 20 women in the centers within the framework of one project, for each unemployed woman whose employment is ensured, from the funds of the State Target Fund for Family and Women's Support to business entities in the prescribed manner Let it be accepted for information that the allocation of a state grant in the amount not exceeding 3 million soums is envisaged.

2. The following should be defined as the main tasks of the centers:

production and service in areas such as tailoring, confectionery, cooking in the neighborhoods in order to ensure the employment of unemployed women, especially in rural areas, who stay at home with children, as well as women included in the "Women's Register" to establish activities;

taking into account the geographical location of the neighborhoods, population and growth points in terms of socio-economic development, those who are unemployed but do not have a profession with a desire to work, as well as to further strengthen their knowledge and improve their skills, organization of training in relevant professions and entrepreneurial skills for women who wish to study additional professions and trades in order to expand their entrepreneurship. Helping them to start and develop business activities in their future occupations;

providing the necessary information and recommendations in order to inform the population about the wide opportunities and privileges created for the development of women's entrepreneurship, ensuring their employment, and acquiring a profession;

in order to strengthen women's health, to establish health services such as fitness and shaping;

promotion of a healthy lifestyle, development of women's medical culture, physical training and mass sports activities together with medical prevention;

to provide permanent jobs to women who have been brought to criminal responsibility, preventively registered, who have returned from penal institutions, to attract them to entrepreneurial activities and to establish and develop their own activities, employment support in provision, occupation.

3. The Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, regional and Tashkent city governments:

Together with the State Asset Management Agency and the Cadastre Agency under the State Tax Committee, for the construction of center buildings within one month, on the basis of the right to permanent use of the land area of up to 300 square meters from each neighborhood or on the basis of the right to operational management of vacant state property objects divide the neighborhood into citizens' assemblies and organize registration of cadastral documents;

take measures to build and fully equip centers on allocated land areas or vacant state-owned objects within the specified time limits.

4. To approve the regulation on the centers for ensuring the employment of women and strengthening their health in the neighborhoods, which provides for the following, in accordance with the appendix :

establishment of non-legal entity centers in each neighborhood;

the procedure for leasing the buildings of the centers to business entities for a period of 5 years for the organization of tailoring, confectionery, fitness, shaping, women's vocational training activities by the neighborhoods;

the procedure for allocating and using the state grant from the funds allocated annually from the State budget to the State Target Fund for Family and Women's Support for the operation of the centers, grants from international financial institutions;

the procedure for granting state grants to business entities that have started the activity of providing women's employment and strengthening their health, training them in the profession.

5. The following should be designated as sources of funding for the activity of the centers:

Grants allocated from the state budget through the State Target Fund for Family and Women Support;

own funds of business entities;

sponsorship donations of individuals and legal entities;

grants allocated by international financial institutions;

other sources not prohibited by legislation.

6. The Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, regional and Tashkent city governments, the Ministry of Neighborhood and Nurani Support, the Agency for the Development of Neighborhood Work and Entrepreneurship under the Ministry of Economic Development and Poverty Alleviation, the State Tax Committee, the State Asset Management Agency , together with the Chamber of Commerce and Industry, let the buildings of the centers be leased to business entities in the prescribed manner and help the communities in organizing and developing the activities of the centers.

7. The State Committee for Family and Women, the Ministry of Employment and Labor Relations, the Youth Affairs Agency have formed a list of unemployed and needy women who want to learn a specific profession in the centers, especially those included in the "Women's Book". , take measures to attract them to employment centers and vocational training.

8. The Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Sports Development, the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, together with the regions and Tashkent city administrations, organize fitness and shaping training in the centers in order to form a healthy lifestyle in the neighborhoods and strengthen the health of women. to help in the organization of trainings and take necessary measures to attract women to trainings.

In this regard, within the framework of these measures, patronage medical workers and representatives of the district (city) sports development departments regularly cooperate with the women's activists of the neighborhood to form a healthy lifestyle in the neighborhood and strengthen women's health. to provide recommendations on the use of physical education and health training organized in the centers.

9. The National Broadcasting Company of Uzbekistan and the National News Agency of Uzbekistan, together with the State Committee for Family and Women, should be recommended to widely cover the meaning and importance of this decision in the mass media.

10. ZB Mahkamova, Deputy Prime Minister of the Republic of Uzbekistan - Chairman of the State Committee for Family and Women, shall be responsible for monitoring the implementation of this decision.

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## **About the centers for ensuring the employment of women and strengthening their health in the neighborhoods**

### REGULATION

#### **Chapter 1. General rules**

1. This Regulation defines the status, main tasks and organization of the centers for women's employment and health promotion in neighborhoods (hereinafter referred to as centers), as well as the procedure for allocating state grants for the organization of their activities.

2. Centers are established in each neighborhood and are not considered legal entities.

3. Centers are established by district (city) hokimities at the expense of additional sources of local budgets of district (city) hokimities and other sources not prohibited by legislation.

4. The buildings of the centers will be leased for a period of 5 years to business entities for the organization of tailoring, confectionery, fitness, shaping, vocational training activities of women in accordance with the procedure for leasing state property based on the recommendation of women's activists in the neighborhoods.

Online auctions for the lease of the premises of the centers are held only among business entities that have the recommendation of women's activists in the neighborhoods.

The list of these business entities is formed through the national portal "Khotin-qizlar.uz" and is presented by integrating it into the electronic trading platform "E-auction".

5. State grants will be allocated to business entities implementing a social project related to the activities of ensuring employment of women in the centers, strengthening their health and training them for the profession in accordance with the procedure specified in this Regulation.

#### **Chapter 2. The main tasks of the centers**

6. The main tasks of the centers are:

production and service in areas such as tailoring, confectionery, cooking in the neighborhoods in order to ensure the employment of unemployed women, especially in rural areas, who stay at home with children, as well as women included in the "Women's Register" to establish activities;

taking into account the geographical location of the neighborhoods, population and growth points in terms of socio-economic development, those who are unemployed but do not have a profession with a desire to work, as well as to further strengthen their knowledge and improve their skills, organization of training in relevant professions and entrepreneurial skills for women who wish to study additional professions and trades in order to expand their entrepreneurship. Helping them to start and develop business activities in their future occupations;

providing necessary information and recommendations in order to inform the population about the wide opportunities and privileges created for the development of women's entrepreneurship, ensuring their employment, and their occupation;

in order to strengthen women's health, to establish health services such as fitness and shaping;

promotion of a healthy lifestyle, development of women's medical culture, physical training and mass sports activities together with medical prevention;

Providing permanent jobs to women who have been brought to criminal responsibility, preventively registered, returning from penal institutions, involving them in entrepreneurial activities, establishing and developing their own activities, employment support in provision, occupation.

#### **Chapter 3. The procedure for allocating a state grant to business entities and using it**

7. In order to ensure the permanent employment of up to 20 women within the framework of one social project (hereinafter referred to as the project) related to the activities of ensuring the employment of women, strengthening their health and training them for a profession, each person A state grant of not more than 3 million soums will be allocated to business entities from the funds of the Family and Women's Support State Target Fund for unemployed women whose employment is guaranteed.

8. When selecting projects, attention is paid to the following criteria:

compliance of the projects with the tasks of the centers;

that it is aimed at providing women with a permanent job as provided for in [paragraph 12](#) of this Regulation ;

to have the necessary financial resources, machinery, equipment and equipment for the implementation of the project;

suitability of the project to regional development drivers, specialization, relevance, marketability and profitability, social attractiveness;

applicant's experience in the project being organized;

ability to create necessary working conditions for employees and pay decent wages;

in addition to providing employment, there is a possibility of establishing measures for vocational training or upgrading of qualifications of women with insufficient qualifications.

9. The allocated state grant will be directed to the purchase of tools, equipment and equipment necessary for the production and preparation of tailoring, confectionery, cooking and various handicraft products organized in the centers for the purpose of implementing the social project.

10. Allocating and using the state grant for the activity of the centers is carried out in accordance with the scheme in [Appendix 1](#) to this Regulation in the following manner:

**At the 1st stage**, business entities will submit projects and relevant documents to community assemblies in order to receive a state grant for the operation of centers in neighborhoods;

**At the 2nd stage, the** chairmen of the neighborhood citizens' meetings that leased the buildings of the centers, in agreement with the women's activists in the neighborhood, on business subjects who want to establish the activity of the centers based on this Regulation and receive a state grant within three days from the date of submission of information and their proposals on social projects by business entities, a worker under the leadership of the deputy district (city) mayor - head of the Family and Women's Department of the sample composition approved by [Appendix 3](#) to this Regulation presents to groups (hereinafter - district (city) working groups).

Members of district (city) working groups work on a public basis.

The organizational form of work of district (city) working groups is a meeting. Meetings of working groups are formalized with minutes. Meetings of working groups are authorized if at least two-thirds of their members are present on the list;

**In the 3rd stage**, working groups will study proposals for projects within five days, select the best and reasonable proposals based on the criteria in [paragraph 8 of this Regulation](#), and draw up a report. These proposals are presented by the district (city) working groups to the Deputy Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan - the Chairman of the Family and Women's Committee, the heads of the family and women's departments of the deputy governors of the regions and the city of Tashkent;

**At the 4th stage, the** Deputy Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan - the Chairman of the Family and Women's Committee, the deputy governors of the regions and the city of Tashkent - the heads of the family and women's departments summarized the proposals and allocated a state grant within two days. sends an order to the State Committee for Family and Women to consider the issue.

The order sent to the State Committee for Family and Women shall be accompanied by specific information and other relevant documents about the purpose and direction of the implemented project, the number of jobs to be created and the equipment and facilities to be purchased;

**At the 5th stage** , the State Committee for Family and Women receives all the orders for the projects received on a quarterly basis in accordance with [Appendix 2](#) to this Regulation on the provision of state grants for the activities of women's employment and health promotion centers in the neighborhoods of the republic. submits to the commission (hereinafter referred to as the Commission).

The commission ensures comprehensive review of projects based on the requirements of this Regulation, and in necessary cases, inspects projects on site.

The Commission's decision will be adopted according to the established procedure for the best and most reasonable projects.

The list of entrepreneurs to whom a state grant has been allocated is published on the official website of the State Committee for Family and Women;

**At the 6th stage**, funds are transferred to the bank accounts of business entities for the purchase of the goods specified in the grant projects within fifteen working days after the decision on the allocation of the state grant.

Unused balances of the state grant at the end of the year shall be returned to the State Fund for Family and Women's Support;

**At the 7th stage** , business entities that receive a state grant will submit a quarterly report on the use of the state grant to the financial authorities within the time limits and in the order set for budget organizations.

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Targeted spending of the allocated state grant is controlled by the State Committee for Family and Women and the Ministry of Finance.

#### **Chapter 4. Requirements for obtaining government grants for project implementation in centers**

11. Entrepreneurs who have started the activity of providing women's employment, strengthening their health and training them for profession in the centers can apply for a state grant.

12. The state grant is allocated for projects aimed at training the following categories of women in professions and entrepreneurship, ensuring their employment and helping them start entrepreneurship:

Women included in the "Unified Register of Social Protection" as well as in the "Women's Register";

women who are unemployed, especially in rural areas, who are raising children;

women returning from foreign labor migration;

able-bodied unemployed women with disabilities (ensuring their employment in accordance with labor protection requirements and establishing entrepreneurial activities);

in order to reduce informal employment, women who are engaged in daily labor activities and earn income (to ensure their employment, taking into account the types of activities these women are engaged in and their needs and interests, training and employment 'to provide);

women who have suffered from human trafficking, harassment and violence, and who have fallen into a difficult economic situation;

unemployed women who graduated from general secondary and professional educational institutions, could not enter higher education institutions or did not have the opportunity to study in higher education (for modern professions with high demand in the labor market and training in IT technologies and ensuring their employment);

women who have previously been brought to criminal responsibility, preventively registered, and returned from penal institutions.

13. In order to receive a state grant, business entities shall submit the following documents and information to the working groups of the district (city) through the community meeting:

information about the social project implemented in the centers, its business plan, direction of activity and new jobs created;

information about the amount of the state grant required for the project and the purchased equipment, tools and equipment, physical education and health equipment;

certificate of state registration of business entities and copies of the contract between the neighborhood assembly and business entities on leasing the premises of the centers.

#### **Chapter 5. Final Provisions**

14. In order to attract the state grant for the implementation of the project in the centers, to use it in a timely and effective manner, the deputy governor of the district (city) at the district (city) level - the heads of the family and women's departments, Karakalpag at the regional level The Deputy Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Estonia - the Chairman of the Family and Women's Committee, the deputy governors of the regions and the city of Tashkent - the heads of the family and women's departments are responsible.

15. State Committee for Family and Women:

Constantly supervises and monitors the allocation of state grants from the State Target Fund for Family and Women Support, timely and effective use of funds;

every six months, it holds discussions on the work done in this direction.

16. Disputes arising during the application of this Regulation shall be resolved in accordance with the procedure established by law.

17. Officials who are guilty of violating the requirements of this Regulation shall be held responsible in accordance with the legislation.
