Regulation respecting the implementation of the provisions relating to industrial accidents and occupational diseases contained in the Agreement on Social Security between the Gouvernement du Québec and the Government of the French Republic

An Act respecting occupational health and safety

(chapter S-2.1, ss. 170 and 223)

1. Benefits under the Act respecting industrial accidents and occupational diseases (chapter A-3.001) and the regulations thereunder shall be extended to all persons referred to in the Agreement on Social Security between the Gouvernement du Québec and the Government of the French Republic, signed on 17 December 2003, and appearing as Schedule 1.

2. The benefits shall apply in the manner prescribed in the Agreement and in the Administrative Arrangement appearing as Schedule 2.
