OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE 2009 ORDER

Adoption of OHS Code 2009

1 The *Occupational Health and Safety Code 2009* made by the Occupational Health and Safety Council on February 9, 2009 is adopted.

Farming and ranching operations

1.1(1) Subject to subsection (2) and except as expressly provided in this Code, this Code does not apply to the following farming and ranching operations:

- (a) the production of crops, including fruits and vegetables, through the cultivation of land;
- (b) the raising and maintenance of animals or birds;
- (c) the keeping of bees.

(2) For greater certainty, the following are not farming and ranching operations:

- (a) the processing of food or other products from the operations referred to in subsection (1);
- (b) the operations of greenhouses, mushroom farms, nurseries or sod farms;
- (c) landscaping;
- (d) the raising or boarding of pets.

Repeal

2 The *Occupational Health and Safety Code 2006 Order* (AR 288/2006) is repealed.

Coming into force

3 This Regulation comes into force on July 1, 2009.
