Abstract

Appendix 8 establishing **list of types of hazardous work**, which are prohibited or only conditionally allowed for young persons **under 18 years of age**.

Text of paraphrase

“Appendix 8 of Decree 33/1998 provides the list of forbidden and restricted categories hazardous works for minors. It appears from Appendix 8 that the following categories of work are regulated:

- Young persons are forbidden from being employed in tasks injurious to young persons physical health
- Young persons are forbidden from being employed in positions or activities in which there is a high risk of accidents
- Young persons are forbidden from being employed where there is a risk of damaging effects from chemical substances, physical and biological agents, and processes including ionizing radiations (there appears to be an extensive list of these types of work in Appendix 8)
- The maximum load for lifting work done by young persons is set at 70% of the load for male adults”.
