ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN CABINET UNDER THE S. R. O. AUTHORITY OF SECTION 10 OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOUR No. 57 of ORDINANCE (CAP. 93).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the

DEPARTMENT OF LABOUR (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1986

and shall be read as one with the Department of Labour Order, S.R.O. No. 57 of 1958, hereinafter referred to as the principal Order.

- 2. Powers of Labour Commissioner. The principal Order is hereby amended in paragraph 2 by adding thereto the following sub-paragraph as sub-paragraph (i):
 - "(i) to interrogate, alone or in the presence of witnesses, the employer or the staff of any undertaking on any matters concerning the application of the legal provisions with respect to terms and conditions of employment relevant to that undertaking".
- 3. Commencement. This Order shall come into effect as from the 20th day of February, 1986.
