

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 97**LABOUR INSTITUTIONS ACT***(No. 12 of 2007)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 46 of the Labour Institutions Act, 2007, the Minister for Labour makes the following Order:—

**THE REGULATION OF WAGES (AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2010**

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Wages (Agricultural Industry) (Amendment) Order, 2010, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st May, 2010.

2. The Regulation of Wages (Agricultural Industry) Order is amended by deleting the Schedule thereto and inserting the following new Schedule:
