ORDER NO. 11/1977

WITH RESPECT TO THE HOURS OF WORK DURING THE HOLY MONTH OF RAMADHAN FOR NON-MOSLEM WORKERS

The Minister for Labour and Social Affairs;

in pursuance to paragraphs 2 and 7 of Article 78 of the Labour Law for the Private Sector promulgated by Amiri Decree Law No. 23 of 1976;

ORDERS

Article 1

The provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 78 of the aforementioned Labour Law for the Private Sector which prohibit the employment of workers for more than six hours a day or 36 hours a week during the Holy Month of Ramadhan shall not be applicable to non-Moslem workers. However, the employment of these workers during the Holy Month shall take place in accordance with the other provisions prescribed in this Law.

Article 2

This Order shall be published in the Official Gazette and it shall come into effect in the Holy Month of Ramadhan in each year.
