ORDER NO. 19/1976

RESPECTING THE LIMITATION OF INSTANCES AND OCCUPATIONS IN WHICH WORK MAY CONTINUE WITHOUT REST BREAK

The Minister for Labour and Social Affairs;

in pursuance of Article 78 of the Labour Law for the Private Sector promulgated by Amiri Decree Law No. 23/1976;

ORDERS

Article 1

Work may continue without rest break in the following instances and occupations provided that the employer shall give permission to workers to take their drink, snacks or rest during work in a way to be regulated by the management of the establishment:

- (1) employment in operations which continue without cessation on a regular shift schedule;
- (2) employment in public utilities and wireless and radio communications;
- (3) employment in the operation of power generators;
- (4) employment in administrative and office work and the like;
- (5) employment in offices of airline companies, airports and ports;
- (6) employment in hospitals, sanatoria and other infimaries;
- (7) the plastic industries;
- (8) cinemas and theatres;
- (9) employment in bakeries
- (10) employment in pharmacies;
- (11) travelling salesmen and commercial representatives when performing their duties outside their establishments.

Article 2

This Order shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall come into operation as from 15th August, 1976.
