## ORDER NO. 20/1976

# LIMITING DAYS OF FEASTS, SEASONS, OTHER OCCASIONS AND SEASONAL WORK ON WHICH WORKERS MAY BE REQUIRED TO WORK OVERTIME

The Minister for Labour and Social Affairs;

in pursuance of Article 79 of the Labour Law for the Private Sector promulgated by Amiri Decree Law No. 23/1976;

#### **ORDERS**

### Article 1

Days of feasts, seasons, other occasions and seasonal work on which a worker may be required to work overtime, provided that the regular and overtime hours shall not exceed sixty hours per week unless approval for longer periods to meet an emergency is given by the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs, are as follows:

First — The month of Ramadhan with regard to all commercial establishments;

Second — The three days preceding Id-Al-Adha and the three days preceding the Gregorian New Year's Day with regard to all commercial establishments.

#### Article 2

This Order shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall come into operation as from 15th August, 1976.
