In re OZORIO (No. 2)

Judgment No. 198

THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint against the World Health Organization (WHO) drawn up by Mr. Peter Ozorio on 6 October 1972;

- A. Considering that the complainant impugns the decision dated 28 July 1972 of the Director-General of the WHO informing him that, on the recommendation of the WHO Headquarters Board of Inquiry and Appeal dated 24 July 1972, he dismissed an appeal lodged on 6 March 1972 by Mr. Ozorio on the grounds that it was time-barred and therefore irreceivable:
- B. Considering that, by a letter dated 3 January 1973 to the Registry of the Tribunal, the complainant informed the Tribunal that he wished to withdraw his complaint and that, by a letter dated 29 January 1973, the defendant Organization informed the Tribunal that it had no objection to the removal of the case from the Tribunal's list;
- C. Considering that Mr. Ozorio has made an unqualified withdrawal of the suit;

DECISION:

The withdrawal of suit by Mr. Ozorio is hereby recorded.
