THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the eleventh complaint filed by Mr H. S. against the European Patent Organisation (EPO) on 9 May 2015;

Considering Article II, paragraph 5, of the Statute of the Tribunal and Article 7 of its Rules;

Having examined the written submissions:

CONSIDERATIONS

- 1. By a letter of 9 May 2015, the complainant, a former permanent employee of the European Patent Office, the EPO's secretariat, filed a complaint with the Tribunal at the same time as four other permanent employees in order to challenge the application of decisions CA/D 27/08 and CA/D 32/08 of the Administrative Council, the former introducing monthly gross salary scales and the latter amending the Regulation on Internal Tax.
- 2. By an e-mail of 1 June 2015 the Registrar asked him to correct his submissions within 30 days in accordance with Article 6, paragraph 2, of the Rules of the Tribunal, by supplying in particular the individual final decision informing him of the dismissal of his

internal appeal and the payslips on which he relied in order to challenge the lawfulness of the aforementioned decisions.

- 3. Despite the reminder sent to him by the Registrar, the complainant failed to produce any of the missing documents within the prescribed time limit.
- 4. Since the complainant has not therefore corrected his complaint, as required by the above-mentioned Article 6, paragraph 2, it is clearly irreceivable and must be summarily dismissed under the procedure provided for in Article 7 of the Rules of the Tribunal.

DECISION

For the above reasons, The complaint is dismissed.
