Judgment No. 86

THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint against the United International Bureaux for the Protection of Intellectual Property, drawn up by Mr. Wipf on 23 April 1965,

- A. Considering that the said complaint prays for the quashing of a decision to assign complainant to a grade and salary scale established for the purpose of assimilating the conditions of employment of the staff of the United International Bureaux to those of the common system of the United Nations and the specialised agencies, and further prays for the regrading of complainant in a higher grade corresponding to the level of his former duties and responsibilities;
- B. Considering that by an instrument dated 25 May 1965, filed with the Registrar prior to the filing of the Organisation's reply, complainant stated that he withdrew any claim whatsoever with respect to the relief prayed for in his complaint; and furthermore that, by letter dated 1 June 1965, the Organisation stated that it had no other submissions to make;

DECIDES:

The Tribunal notifies the parties that Mr. Wipf's withdrawal of suit is hereby recorded.
