# In re LAJUST-PICHON

### Judgment 983

#### THE ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL,

Considering the complaint filed by Mrs. Danièle Lajust- Pichon against the European Organization for Nuclear Research (CERN) on 20 September 1988 and corrected on 28 September;

Considering the applications to intervene filed by:

Mrs. Régine Chareyron

Mr. Jean-Paul Gendras

Mr. Marc Goujon

Mr. Jean-Claude Langelez

Mr. Daniel Vintras

Considering that by a letter of 1 December 1988 to the Registrar of the Tribunal the complainant's counsel said that she withdrew suit;

Considering the letter the complainant's counsel wrote to the Registrar on 13 January 1989 saying that Mrs. Chareyron, Mr. Gendras, Mr. Goujon and Mr. Vintras withdrew their applications;

Considering that by a letter of 2 February 1989 to the Registrar the Organization stated that it had no observations on the withdrawal;

Considering the observations submitted by the Chairman of the CERN Staff Association on 29 November 1988;

## CONSIDERATIONS:

By a letter which the Registrar of the Tribunal received on 2 December 1988 the complainant withdrew her complaint.

The Organization and four of the interveners accepted that withdrawal, but the Chairman of the Staff Association states objections. The Tribunal will not entertain those objections since an intervener has no greater rights than the complainant, who alone may determine whether to maintain his suit.

The withdrawal being unqualified, the Tribunal will simply record it.

#### **DECISION:**

The withdrawal of suit is hereby recorded.
