Legal status of the Institute

- The Central Institute for Labour Protection was established by an act of law of 4 April, 1950
- From 1956 the Institute operated under the auspices of the Central Council of Trade Unions
- Since 1973 the Institute had operated under the Minister of Labour, Wages and Social Welfare, and currently under the Minister of Labour and Social Policy
- In 2002 the Institute received the status of a national research institute - PIB (Resolution of the Council of Ministers of 5 November, 2002)



CIOP-PIB

The mission is:

- to conduct scientific research aimed at new technological and organizational solutions which are useful in the design of working conditions that conform to OSH and ergonomics requirements
- to determine scientific foundations for the development of socio-economic policies of Poland in the field of OSH

R&D departments:

- Vibroacustic Hazards
- Safety Engineering
- Chemical and Aerosol Hazards
- Ergonomics
- Bioelectromagnetic Hazards
- Personal Protective Equipment
- OSH Management





Main areas of CIOP-PIB's activities

- Research and development
- Standardization of methods and OSH requirements
- Determination of exposure limits
- Development and implementation of OSH-related technical solutions, software tools, databases etc.
- Testing and certification of PPE and machinery
- Promotion of OSH management systems
- Education and training in OSH
- Certification of personnel's competence and of OSH educational bodies
- Dissemination of OSH-related information by publications, posters, websites, library and information centre activities

Phase 1 is carried out in 2008-2010.







CIS Information System



Polish National CIS Centre – development (1)

- At the end of 1959 talks of CIS Director Marcel Robert with the representative of the CIOP, then – correspondence with CIOP Director L. Taniewski on proposal for CIOP
- Polish CIS Centre was organized in 1960 (one year after the International CIS Centre)
- The CIS Centre activities were fulfilled by the Information and Documentation Centre of CIOP
- Constant cooperation with CIS





Polish National CIS Centre – development (2)

- Since 1961 CIOP- CIS Centre has been contributed to elaborating the OSH literature abstracts on CIS cards:
 - prepared the abstracts in English of Polish OSH publications
 - sent the original documents to CIS Geneva for making microfishes and paper copies
- Chosen by CIS HQ Polish abstracts were inserted into CIS information cards on subscription
- In 1973-1974 Polish abstracts started to be inserted into the paid CISDOC database
- Since 1994 available on new CIS website, since 2004 free of charge





Polish National CIS Centre – development (3)

- All those years the Polish CIS Centre has been:
 - collecting and lending all CIS HQ publications
 - liaising between Polish users and CIS HQ and the network
 - identifying the subscribers of CIS services in Poland (than - among others, subscribers of CISDOC database and ILO-CIS Bulletin
 - carrying out information activities for Polish and foreign users





Polish National CIS Centre – development (4)

- In early 1990s CIOP started cooperating with CIS HQ on Thesaurus, using the CIS Thesaurus as a referrence for elaborating the CIOP Thesaurus:
 - in 1991 translation into Polish and adaptation of CIS Thesaurus of 1976
 - in 1990s- database THES (MICRO-CDS/ISIS), over 7 000 words, in Polish
 - in 2008-2009 about 12 000 words in 4 languages
- Constant cooperation on thesauruses:
 - getting the new descriptors from CIS HQ
 - sending proposals of new descriptors
 - exchanging ideas and information





Polish National CIS Centre – development (5)

- During 49 years different stages of cooperation with CIS HQ and the network, but still the cooperation existed and was gradually developed
- From 1994 quick development of the Polish CIS Centre, introducing new forms of activities, eg. spreading CIS information via Internet, Polish CIS website since 2000, broader promotion of CIS in Poland as well as of World Day for Safety and Health at Work, a new database OSH - BHP





Polish National CIS Centre – development (6)


- Representatives of CIS Poland took an active part in CIS Meetings courses, (e.g. Finland in 1997), conferences (e.g. Dublin in 2000), workshops (e.g. Geneva in 2004), accompanied-by meetings (e.g. OSH Networks Meeting in Dusseldorf in 2007); also the number of working visits were increased
- Running and developing the Polish National CIS Centre started in 2002 to be a project in the frame of the NATIONAL PROGRAMME "Adaptation of working conditions in Poland to European Union Standards" (2002 – 2007) and then - New NATIONAL PROGRAMME "Improvement of safety and working conditions" (phase 1 is beeing carried out in 2008-2010)
 - it enabled to broaden the Polish CIS Centre activities





Polish National CIS Centre in 2008-2009: Main Tasks

- Taking part in the international elaboration of OSH information sources, what allows on the international promotion of Polish OSH publications and achievements through the CIS information system
- OSH information service for Polish and foreign specialists based, among others, on CIS sources
- Dissemination of information in Poland on the International CIS Centre and the whole network
- Development of cooperation with CIS Centres network







International Promotion of Polish Publications and Achievements (1)

- Participation in the development of international OSH information sources
 - collaborating with the International CIS Centre on the development of CISDOC, CISDOC-Text and Virtual Bulletin –abstracts of Polish OSH publications are prepared and chosen by CIS HQ are included in CISDOC (in 2008 – 225 abstracts)
 - sending Polish documents to be included in the CIS Library, Geneva. Information on these documents is available on the International CIS Centre website
 - developing the Polish CIS Centre collaborating group of Polish institutions
 - publishing in CIS connected sources (e.g., CIS Newsletter, CIS websites, new CIS databases) information on important Polish OSH events



International Promotion of Polish Publications and Achievements (2)


- Providing Polish OSH information for CIS Centres and other foreign users
- Developing an English version of the Polish CIS Centre website (since 2000)
- Developing a database on Polish literature OSH-BHP in English (since 2005, documents – from 1983, now over 1600 doc.)
- Contacts with International and other CIS Centres
- Participating in CIS events such as CIS meetings and courses on new OSH information sources




OSH-BHP database of Polish OSH literature in English: the Polish National CIS Centre








Information Service for Polish users (1)

- Collecting documents received, e.g. from the CIS network: acquisition, cataloguing and storage
- Lending the materials by the CIOP-PIB library
- Responding to queries from Polish (and foreign) specialists
- Preparing lists of literature on chosen subjects
- Providing full texts of documents (CISDOC-TEXT database)







Information Service for Polish users (2)

- Disseminating electronic and printed information from CIS network and other sources of information
 - e-mail service (in 2008-2009 over 3 000 users)
 - distribution of CIS and ILO publications on OSH events (fairs, conferences, courses, etc.)
- Developing and constant up-dating of the Polish CIS Centre website – in Polish and in English





CIOP-PIB Library

- An interdisciplinary collection on OSH and many OSH-related disciplines, in 2008:
 - about 30 500 volumes
 - 180 Polish journals (in it 102 scientific and specialist) and 86 foreign titles
- Collection on OSH of historical value
- Databases, information materials and reports on research results

Contacts and cooperation with CIS Network

- Exchanging information and cooperation with the International CIS Centre (developing the Thesaurus, databases, websites and others)
- Cooperating with the other CIS Centres, exchange of information and documents
- Participating in meetings of CIS Centres and international conferences (exchange of materials and information)
- Working visits to other CIS Centres
- Working visits of the International CIS Centre and other CIS Centres representatives to the Polish CIS Centre



Promotion of the CIS Network in Poland




- Polish CIS Centre website on the CIOP-PIB portal
- Electronic information emails; in 2008 more than 3000 users
- Articles in printed and electronic journals (altogether more than 20 articles), texts in books
- Conferences of information science specialists (in presentations and in conference proceedigns), e.g. in 2008

 the Conference on information management, in 2009 –
 10th Forum of Scientific and Technical Information
- By the CIOP-PIB library and during exhibitions
- Courses and training sessions at CIOP-PIB and other institutions
- OSH events (Sawo fairs, picnics, workshops)
- Presentations at meetings and conferences on OSH
