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Report of the Committee of Experts on the Application of Conventions and Recommendations (Geneva, 25 November–7 December 2024)

1. The Committee of Experts on the Application of Conventions and Recommendations held its 95th Session from 25 November to 7 December 2024.¹ It adopted a report which, in accordance with the usual practice, is published as a document for the International Labour Conference² and is submitted to the Governing Body at its present session. This report has been published in two parts (Parts A and B) for the sake of convenience.
2. Under its terms of reference, the Committee was called upon to examine:
 - (a) reports supplied by governments on the application of Conventions that they have ratified (articles 22 and 35 of the Constitution);
 - (b) information supplied by governments on the submission of certain Conventions, Recommendations and Protocols to the competent authorities (article 19 of the Constitution); and
 - (c) reports and supplementary information supplied by governments on the Workmen's Compensation (Agriculture) Convention, 1921 (No. 12), the Equality of Treatment (Accident Compensation) Convention, 1925 (No. 19), the Equality of Treatment (Accident Compensation) Recommendation, 1925 (No. 25), the Social Security (Minimum Standards) Convention, 1952 (No. 102) (Part VI), the Employment Injury Benefits Convention, 1964 [Schedule I amended in 1980] (No. 121), and the Employment Injury Benefits

Recommendation, 1964 (No. 121), as decided by the Governing Body (article 19 of the Constitution).

3. In particular, the Governing Body's attention is drawn to the Committee's General Survey entitled *Achieving comprehensive employment injury protection*. This General Survey will be found in Report III (Part B). It is based on reports supplied under articles 19 and 22 of the ILO Constitution.
