Report of the Joint Inspection Unit of the United Nations on its activities for the year ended 31 December 2000

1. This is the thirty-second report of its kind prepared by the Joint Inspection Unit.¹ The report contains six sections, covering the list of participating organizations; the composition of the Unit; its human and financial resources; the programme of work; its interactions with member States/legislative organs, participating organizations, and oversight bodies; and follow-up on JIU reports and recommendations.
2. The JIU lists, in the annex to the report, the nine reports and five notes issued in the year 2000.
3. As in the past, system-wide JIU reports will continue to be submitted to the Programme, Financial and Administrative Committee or to the Committee on Technical Cooperation once the comments of the Administrative Committee on Coordination (ACC) on the reports are issued. Since the November 2000 session of the Governing Body, when JIU reports were last discussed, no ACC comments have been received.
