



## SECOND ITEM ON THE AGENDA

**Effect to be given to the recommendations  
of sectoral meetings****(b) Tripartite Meeting on the Evolution of  
Employment, Working Time and Training  
in the Mining Industry  
(Geneva, 7-11 October 2002)**

1. The Tripartite Meeting on the Evolution of Employment, Working Time and Training in the Mining Industry was held in Geneva from 7 to 11 October 2002, chaired by Mr. Guillaume Attigbe, Worker member of the Governing Body.
2. The Meeting considered a report prepared by the International Labour Office.<sup>1</sup> It adopted a set of conclusions, and two resolutions concerning mining, finance and sustainable development, and the future ILO work programme for the mining sector.
3. These texts, together with a summary of the proceedings of the Meeting, appear in the *Note on the Proceedings*, which is appended to the present paper.<sup>2</sup> Paragraphs 25-32 of the conclusions and the operative paragraphs of the resolutions call for action by the ILO.
4. *The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body authorize the Director-General to communicate the Note on Proceedings containing the texts mentioned in paragraph 3 above –*
  - (a) *to governments, requesting them to communicate these texts to the employers' and workers' organizations concerned;*
  - (b) *to the international employers' and workers' organizations concerned;*
  - (c) *to the other international organizations concerned.*
