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I. Progress in international labour legislation

II. Internal administration

4. Article 4.2(d) of the Staff Regulations states:

Vacancies in the Director and Principal Officer category shall be filled by the Director-General by transfer in the same grade, promotion or appointment. Such promotions or appointments, other than to vacancies in technical cooperation projects, shall be reported to the Governing Body with a short statement of the qualifications of the persons so promoted or appointed.

Mr. Shinichi Hasegawa (Japan)

Appointed Director of the ILO Office in Japan in Tokyo with effect from 1 January 2006.

Mr. Virgilio Levaggi Vega (Peru)

Appointed Deputy Regional Director of the ILO Regional Office for Latin America and the Caribbean in Lima with effect from 1 January 2006. Born in 1956.

Mr. Levaggi Vega graduated from the Pontifical Catholic University of Peru with diplomas in Humanities and Law and was in residence at the Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs at Princeton University (United States).

Mr. Levaggi Vega joined the ILO in 1994 as Senior Specialist on Employers' Activities for Chile and MERCOSUR until 1998. He was then appointed Chief of the Programming and Technical Cooperation Unit at the Regional Office for Latin America and the Caribbean in Lima. Between 2000 and 2002, Mr. Levaggi Vega held the position of Senior Programme Analyst at headquarters, transferring to Lima in 2002 as Regional Specialist on Socio-economic Integration and Decent Work. From 2004, he was Acting Deputy Regional Director for the Americas and the Caribbean.

Prior to joining the ILO, Mr. Levaggi Vega held, among others, the following positions: Board and Executive Member of non-profit organizations; Managing Director and Adviser to the President of the Confederation of Private Business Associations (CONFIEP); and Chief Adviser to the President of the Ministers' Council, as well as to the Minister of Labour and Social Promotion in Peru. In 1993, he was invited by the United Nations Secretary-General to become a member of the World Summit for Social Development International Team of Advisers.

Mr. Mark Levin (Israel)

Appointed Chief of the Human Resources Operations and Development Branch in the Human Resources Development Department in the Management and Administration Sector and promoted to D.1 with effect from 1 January 2006. Born in 1954.

Mr. Levin graduated with an Honours degree in Sociology from the Polytechnic of North London (United Kingdom) and undertook postgraduate Labour Studies at Tel Aviv University (Israel).

Mr. Levin joined the ILO in 1996 as Chief Technical Adviser of an Inter-regional Cooperative Human Resources Development Programme. In 1998 he was appointed Senior Specialist on Cooperative Human Resource Development and in 2003 became Head of the Management Support Unit of the Employment Sector. He has coordinated a number of International Labour Conference committee secretariats, including the Human Resources Development Committee in 2003 and 2004 and served as Deputy Representative of the Secretary-General at the 2005 ILC discussion on Youth Employment.

Prior to joining the ILO, Mr. Levin was employed from 1982 to 1996 as Senior Lecturer at the International Institute (formerly Afro-Asian Institute) of the Histadrut, Israel's General Federation of Labour. During this period, he conducted labour and cooperative leadership training courses in Israel, Africa, Asia, the Americas and Central and Eastern Europe for officials of trade unions, cooperatives, ministries of labour and community organizations. In 1994, he was appointed Deputy Director of the Institute.

Mr. Daniel Martínez y Fernandez (Spain)

Appointed Regional Director of the ILO Regional Office for Latin America and the Caribbean in Lima and promoted to D.2 with effect from 1 January 2006. Promotion to D.1 was reported to the Governing Body in November 2001.

Mr. Guillermo Miranda Rojas (Chile)

Appointed Director of the ILO Subregional Office for the South Cone of Latin America in Santiago with effect from 1 January 2006. Born in 1951.

Mr. Miranda Rojas has a BA in History and a Masters degree in History from the University of Paris VIII, France. He also holds a D.E.A from the University of Paris I, Sorbonne, France.

Mr. Miranda Rojas joined the ILO in 2003 as Director of the ILO Office for Mexico and Cuba in Mexico.

During the 1980s and prior to joining the ILO, Mr. Miranda Rojas was a Specialist on Non-Governmental Cooperation in France, acting as Coordinator for several European NGO associations for Nicaragua, El Salvador, Haiti and as Officer for Projects in Latin America for the Catholic Committee against Hunger and for Development (CCFD) France.

During the 1990s, Mr. Miranda Rojas was Director of the Latin American Institute of International Studies (ILET) in Chile and National Coordinator of the UNDP Project “Support to the Management of the International Cooperation Agency of Chile”. Subsequently, he was Adviser and Head of Cabinet in the Ministries of Education, Labour, and the General Secretariat of the Government and the General Secretariat of the Presidency. From 2000 to 2003, Mr. Miranda Rojas held the position of Head of Cabinet of the Chilean Ministry of the Interior.
