Failure to supply information in reply to comments made by the Committee of Experts and failure to supply reports for the past five years on unratified Conventions and Recommendations

The Government has provided the following written information.

As part of the efforts of the Government towards ensuring full respect of its reporting obligations, the Ministry of Public Service and Labour consults extensively with all social partners in the process of adopting reports due for submission to the International Labour Office. In this regard, a meeting of the National Labour Council is scheduled on the 30th of May 2024 to validate the reports on both ratified and unratified conventions and recommendations, after which all pending reports will be submitted to the ILO, no later than June 2024.
