► Important note on voting sessions in June 2024

► Vote on the abrogation of Conventions

The steps below apply to the vote on the abrogation of Conventions and to any other **Yes/No/Abstention** vote.

1. An email will be dispatched to your email address (the email address that was provided at the point of accreditation – please ensure that your email address is accurate and working). It contains an embedded link to the voting system as well as a first voting code. Please click on **Go to login**.

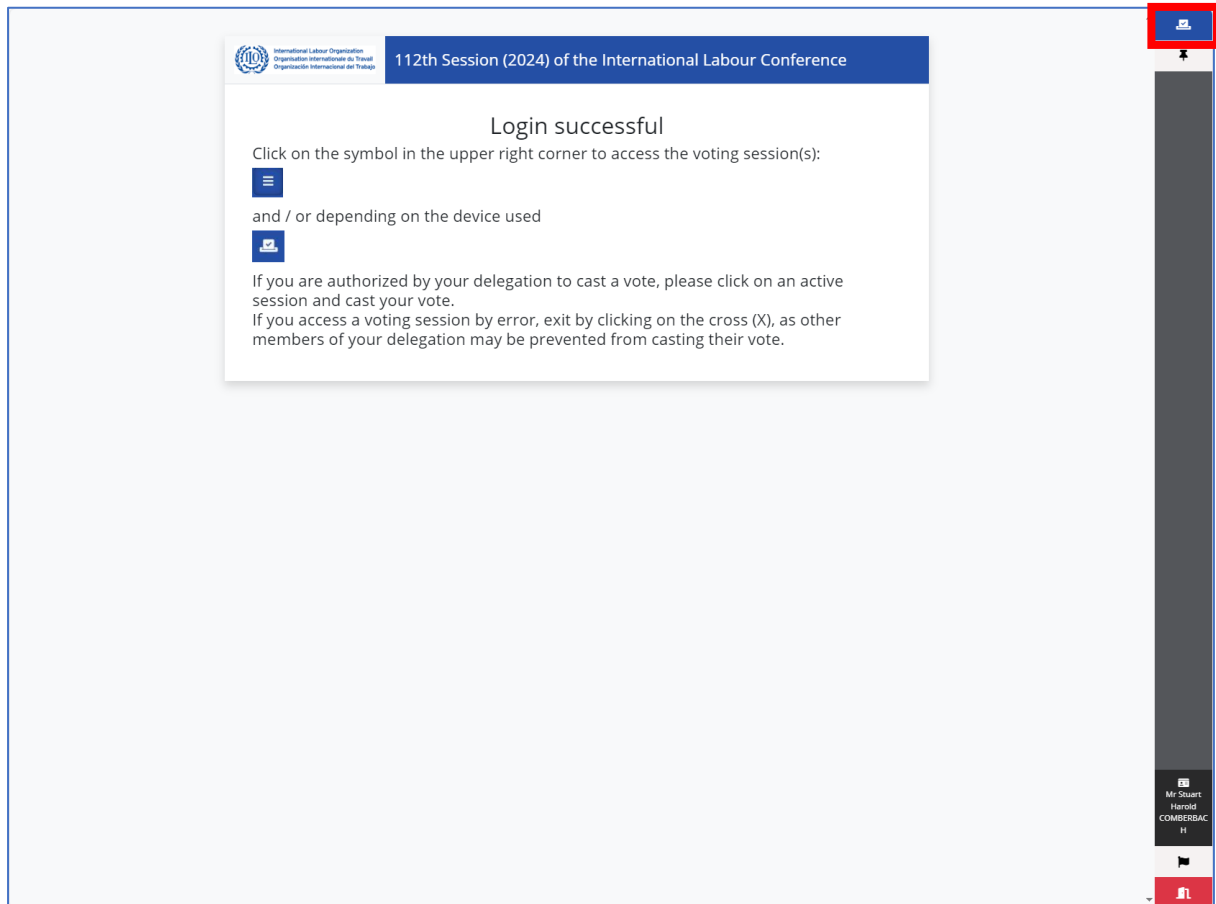
